


1. Make a horizontal ellipse using the Ellipse tool.

- p 2. Using the convert anchor points tool, convert the anchor points at either end of the ellipse. Command-2 to Lock the shape.
- o 3. Using the pen tool, add a tail, fins, and gills. Command-2 to Lock the shape.
  - Draw a single scalloped line, and Option-Shift-Drag it to make one copy in the middle of the fish and one copy at the end.
  - . Use the Resize tool to make the scalloped lines the appropriate length.
  - Double-click on the Blend tool and set the options to specified steps with 2 steps. Make a blend between the gills and scales.
  - With the blend still highlighted, select: Object > Expand.
- p 8. Make an eye using the Ellipse tool, give it a stroke of white, with a fill of black.
  Command-Option-2 to Unlock
  Command-A to Select All
  - Select the new brush option from the Brush palette. Name the brush by double-clicking on it to open the dialogue box. Choose theArt Brush option.
  - 10. Choose the brush from the Tool palette, and paint some fish.
