






# Make a Canoe



- 1) Create an **Ellipse** with a **dark brown fill** and a **darker stroke**
- 2) Create a second, smaller **Ellipse** of the **same fill and stroke**, placing it on the first shape as shown. Select both objects and apply the **Minus Front Pathfinder Filter**. When you have finished this step your illustration will look like the third illustration at the left side of the page.
- 3) Use the **Direct Selection Tool** (shown at left), to select the bottom anchor point of the object and tweak it upwards a few points to flatten it slightly.
- 4) VOILA! A canoe!
- 5) Use the **Pen Tool** to draw a line that approximates the shape of the canoe, and apply a border design from the **Border Sample Brushes** selection.
- 6) (a) Create a long **Rectangle** with round corners, a **beige fill**, and a **darker stroke**. (b) Then create on top of that an **ellipse** with the same colours. (c) Select both shapes, and apply the **Unite Pathfinder Filter**. (d) Select the bottom point of the oar and with the **Convert Anchor Points Tool**, reshape the bottom of the oar.
- 7) Select the oar and **rotate** it to **30°** placing it in front of the canoe.
